(from 20/08/2013 to 14/07/2016)	<p>As I have had several occasions to visit CIArb Malaysian Branch in the past including the peer interview examination in July 2013 to be a Fellowship member of CIArb, I became acquaintance with several Malaysian Arbitrators and they guided me to come to know about the Construction Industry Payment & Adjudication Act 2012 under the Law of Malaysia.</p> <p>As there was Adjudication Training Programme organized by Kuala Lumpur Regional Centre of Arbitration (KLRCA) from 20 – 24 April 2015, I participated the programme.</p> <p>The training is conducted over five days by experts from the construction industry and consists of five units.</p> <p>UNIT 1 The Application of Statutory Adjudication to the Construction Industry Enables the participants to acquire knowledge and develop a better understanding of adjudication and the effects of the Construction Industry Payment and Adjudication Act (CIPAA) 2012 on the construction industry.</p> <p>UNIT 2 The Practice & Procedure of Adjudication under the CIPAA Gives participants a deeper knowledge of the important provisions of CIPAA and understand the necessary requirements of the adjudication process.</p> <p>UNIT 2A CIPAA Regulations Introduces participants to the Regulations of the Act which will give full effect and the better carrying out of the provisions of CIPAA 2012</p> <p>UNIT 3 Fundamentals of Construction Law Introduces the participants to the Malaysian Legal System and provides the basic knowledge of construction law, which includes basic concepts of the law of contract, tort and evidence.</p> <p>UNIT 4 The Construction Process Introduces the participants to the basic knowledge of the construction process in particular procurement, processes and contractual arrangements.</p> <p>UNIT 5 Writing Adjudication Decisions Provides participants the skills necessary to write an adjudication decision in accordance with the provisions in CIPAA.</p> <p>The result of the examination was successful and I was awarded KLRCA Certificate in Adjudication and later empanelled in KLRCA Panel of Arbitrator and Adjudicator.</p>
